NHS Test & Trace

NHS Test and Trace is a key part of the country's ongoing COVID-19 response. If they can rapidly detect people who have recently come into close contact with a new COVID-19 case, they can take swift action to minimise transmission of the virus. This is important as lockdown measures are eased and will help us return to a more normal way of life and reduce the risk of needing local lockdowns in the future.

We are helping NHS Test and Trace by encouraging our volunteers and customers to use the NHS Covid-19 QR Code app on their smartphone or by leaving their contact details with us by completing a Test and Trace form when they visit the library. By keeping a temporary record of our customers and visitors for 21 days we will be able to assist with requests for that information if needed. This could help contain clusters or local outbreaks of Coronavirus and help stop the spread of Covid.
